Old Business: A meeting place for the winter was discussed. The October meeting will be at the field. Bad weather meeting place will be at Hostetler Tire. Members will be notified by email the night before. The library is an option as well as the community center for the rest of the year and into next year. Craig and Eric to finalize.

New Business: The new reel mower will need a small supply of replacement parts. Jerry will order them and a few small hand tools and store in a small box by the pin box. Eric to supply an electrical box for their storage. A garden tractor was brought to the field to be reviewed for a possible purchase. Several members drove it while connected to the new reel mower. Motion made to buy with one dissension vote with the following conditions. Mower must have a working mower deck with all working and good condition belts. The blade and snow blower condition optional but a plus. Asking price \$250. Rob donated two car batteries for field use. Jerry to get a plastic tub to store them in by the shelter. They are to be used for field chargers and engine starting. Jerry to explore solar chargers and report in October. The lease is still pending. Craig will contact the county on simplifying the procedure.

Editors Comments: The field has been kept in excellent condition this year. The expansion has met more to mow but sure is a welcome addition.
